

Rogers City Elementary School Phase 5 Covid Plan

School/Employees

- *School employees will be required to wear masks in hallways and in shared classrooms where students of various grade levels gather one class after the next (Resource Room, Fine Arts/Computers, Interventions, RTR, Library, Restrooms).
- *All employees will be given a Face Shield provided by the district.
- *Hand Sanitizing/Hand Washing will take place frequently by employees.
- *School Employees will teach students the correct Hand Washing/Sanitizing techniques.
- *As soon as supplies are available, all teacher desks will have shields.
- *A room in the office area has been designated as the "Quarantine Room" for all students that have Covid symptoms.
- *All classrooms will be disinfected throughout the day. Shared classrooms will be disinfected after each class leaves the room. The custodial staff will disinfect all desks, table tops, chairs, and lockers each evening as well.
- *Teachers will space student tables and/or desks 6' apart where possible.

Parents/Students

- *The district will be offering 3 orange and black homemade masks to every student. Students can wear these masks or their own. Regardless of which mask is worn, we are asking that the students are always wearing a clean mask. Please wash the masks at home daily. We will also have a supply of clean masks in the school and be washing any mask that we deem unsanitary.
- *Students will wear masks in the hallways and in classrooms where various grade levels gather one class after the next (Resource Room, Fine Arts/Computers, Interventions, RTR, Library, Restrooms). Masks must be worn on the bus as well.
- *Students that do not have a mask to wear will not be allowed in school.
- *Students that use their mask in any way that they shouldn't be or refuse to wear one will be subject to disciplinary actions.
- *Entrances to the school will be restricted to school employees, students, and auxiliary staff. All others will only be allowed in the building under extenuating circumstances. When these instances do occur, masks must be worn upon entrance and at all times when in the building. **Note:** Unfortunately, parents will not be allowed in the building on the first day of school to take their child into the classroom.
- *Each morning, parents will need to check their child/children for symptoms. Some symptoms to look for are a fever at or above 100.4, sore throat, coughing, runny nose, or nausea. Please keep your child at home if they have any of these symptoms.

	<p>elementary school will be using if a student has symptoms of the infection, been in close contact with a person who has tested positive, and/or has tested positive themselves.</p> <p>*Unlike the past, students will not congregate/line up on the west side of the school before school begins. The entrance doors will be open when they arrive as will their classroom doors. Students will be expected to have a mask on while they walk to their classrooms. The mask can be taken off when they sit down. This will be a time where students can eat their breakfast, complete morning work, and/or silent read. Students are to remain seated during this time span.</p> <p>*Students will take part in Hand Washing/Sanitizing when returning to class from a different classroom. Hand Washing/Sanitizing will take place at other scheduled times as well.</p> <p>*As soon as supplies are available and built, students will have dividers and their tables and/or desks.</p>
<p><u>Lunch and Recesses</u></p> <p>*Lunch and Recesses will be completed in 3 separate shifts in comparison to 2 in the past. This will allow for the students to be spaced out much more than they were in the past. K-1 will eat and go out for recess together. Grades 2-3 will eat and be on the recess grounds together. Lastly, grades 4-5 will eat and be on the recess grounds together. Like the past, students will only sit next to students within their class. Students will wear their masks when walking to the lunchroom. Masks will be dropped off on desks before leaving to the playgrounds for Recess. For lunch and afternoon recesses, students will leave and return through the classroom emergency doors.</p>	<p><u>Breakfast</u></p> <p>*A packed Breakfast will now be served on all students' desks in the morning rather than congregating in the gym or at the breakfast cart.</p>
